

# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Families.

Welcome back!

I hope that you all had a Happy and Holy Easter and that the holidays were a chance to refresh and recharge.

This week has seen us get straight back into our routines and provide meaningful learning experiences for our children.

We had a large number of families and parishioners visit our Prayer Spaces in the Year 5/6 area depicting Easter Sunday and the Resurrection of Jesus. I would like to thank our Year 5/6 children and their teachers for presenting these vital aspects of our faith in such meaningful and interactive formats and for the families that came and visited them.

Our before school reading in the Library re-commenced on Wednesday morning from 8.30am. This is always a great way to start the day by reading as a family, with friends or individually. There is a standing invitation for all families to join us each Wednesday,

On Thursday evening we had two Sacramental meetings, our First Communion Family Workshop (Year 4) and our Confirmation Family Workshop (Year 6). These workshops indicate the formal preparation period for these two Sacraments of Initiation. These gatherings are always inspiring as it allows for families to come together to share and explore their faith and as a school we are privileged to be part of this.

I am therefore asking for parents to complete the survey as the information helps us plan for the future. The survey window is open until next Friday 26 April. I thank you in advance for your involvement.

I would like to remind you that we have 2 School Closure Days planned for next week which allows for Professional Development and dispenses Time in Lieu that our staff have accrued. Due to the availability of Professional Development activities, advice from Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) and public holidays, we will be having school closure days next Wednesday 24 April and Friday 26 April with the ANZAC Day public holiday on Thursday 25 April. Therefore there will be 3 consecutive days when the school is closed.


#### Medical Plans And Asthma Plans

All medications will be stored in individually labelled bags in the school office.

#### Pick-up From After-School

Parents are asked to please be prompt when picking up your child/ren after-school. If a ride is not here when school concludes, the student may be sent to aftercare instead of the office. Please remember school aftercare does have a cost involved and time will begin accruing at the end of the school day. If a student's ride has run into an unexpected delay, please call the main office to let them know.



A reminder to families that arrive before 3.25pm to park in the carpark.
