Please remember that we are here to support our students and families and we are only ever an email, phone call or Seesaw message away.

This week started with the whole school attending Mass on Monday morning to celebrate the **Feast** of **Our Lady**, **Help of Christians**. As well as being a significant event in Australia's Liturgical year, it has added significance as it is being used to **commemorate 200 years of Catholic Education in Australia**. As part of this celebration we had an image of Mary blessed and this will be displayed prominently in our school. All children also received a holy card with a special prayer to recognise this event. I would like to **thank Mrs Stack** for her organisation of this Mass and for **the children who were involved** to make it such a special occasion.

We have had to have a few wet day dismissals recently. When this is the case, the children will remain in their classrooms. Parents can either collect their children from their classroom or if using the pick up zone, staff will organise for the children to come to the Office area and enter


their cars safely. This system has worked efficiently with our first priority being the safety of our children and I thank families for your patience and cooperation.

The class that brings in the most items will win a casual dress day. Please donate to this worthwhile appeal.


